



Evacuate yourself on foot as much as possible because cars can lead to traffic jams and dangerous situations.

Get the right information from the emergency

radio system and TV and radio broadcasts.

Get the right information

Coasts and rivers are dangerous if an earthquake occurs or a tsunami warning or advisory is issued. If you are fishing or swimming, leave the beach immediately and evacuate yourself to a higher place.

If Anyone Needs Help

«Elderly and People with Illnesses Elderly people, children, and people with illnesses need to evacuate first. Everyone should cooperate during the evacuation.



《Hearing-impaired People》

When speaking, face straight on and move your mouth clearly. Use sign language, writing, gestures, etc. to convey information accurately

《Blind People》

Speak clearly and slowly in a loud voice. In the case of guiding a blind person, have the person lightly hold your elbow and walk half a step ahead at a slow speed.






«Disabled People»

In the case of a person who uses a wheelchair, be sure to have at least three people on the stairs for assistance! Have the person facing forward in the case of going upstairs and face backward in the case of going downstairs

Human and material damage can be reduced by coordinating self-help, mutual help, and public help if a disaster occurs. Once a large-scale disaster has occurred, the assistance activities of public institutions may not be able to respond sufficiently due to disruptions in the traffic network or simultaneous multiple fires. Therefore, it is essential not only to prepare for disasters by yourself (self-help) but also to help the local community by helping each other (mutual assistance). You should start activities for strengthening mutual assistance and strengthening local disaster prevention capabilities. You can do this through the organizational activities of voluntary disaster prevention to reduce disaster damage and create a disaster-resistant community.



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
