How to Separate and Dispose of Household Garbage

- Collection service is not available on Sundays, January 1-3. Collection is available on National Holidays.

- Please take out your garbage to the front of your house by 8:00 a.m.
- Unseparated garbage and business waste cannot be collected.
- Garbage will not be collected during stormy weather and route bus services are suspended.
(Please take out the garbage on the next collection day. Please make a reservation call again for collection of bulk garbage.)
- Please refer to the garbage separation guide from the website to check the type of the garbage and how to dispose it.

Combustible Garbage (Urasoe City designated bags)

Please make sure to tie each bag at the top.



*Garbage should be taken out after being put in a designated garbage bag.

Kitchen Garbage

- Vegetable waste, used tea leaves, leftovers, shells, etc.
- Cooking oil



*Please make sure to drain water.

*Cooking oil should be disposed of after being soaked up into a newspaper, etc.

Plastic

- Plastic bags, shopping bags
- Plastic goods
- Styrofoam
- Tapes, CDs, DVDs
- Toys (Metallic toys are non-combustible garbage.)



Wastepaper

- Tissues, paper diapers (Excrements should be flushed in the toilet.)
- Unrecyclable paper (Photos, carbon paper, thermal paper, water-proof paper, etc.)

Other

- Fabrics, clothing
- Rubber, leather goods
- Timbers should be put in a middle or small bags (don't bind) and tie the bag at the top. (The thickness of a Square log should be less than 5 cm, and a plate should be less than 1 cm.) Up to 3 bags per 1 family.
- *All needles and screws should be removed.
- *If the garbage is considered to damage the collection truck, it should be treated as bulk garbage, even if it meets all the requirements.

Non-Combustible Garbage (Urasoe City designated bags)

Please make sure to tie each bag at the top.



One bag up to 10kg

*Garbage should be taken out after being put in a designated garbage bag.

Metals

- Pots, frying pans, kettles, iron scraps
- Umbrellas, wires, hangers, cutlery
- Paint cans, etc.



Glass/Bottles

- Glass cups, sheet glass
- LED lamps, incandescent lamps
- Cosmetic bottles, broken bottles, glass oil bottles, etc.
- *Jam jar lids and coffee can caps too!



Ceramics

- Rice bowls, plates, vases, earthen pots, etc.
- Flowerpots (Plastic pots are combustible garbage.)



Other

- DVD players, fans, vacuum cleaners, lids of a mosquito coil can and sponge inside.
- *Small electric appliances, except for bulky garbage and recyclable home appliances, which can be contained in a bag (max. 10kg).



How to Dispose of Non-Combustible Garbage

*Knives and broken and dangerous goods should be disposed of after being wrapped in several newspapers marked with 'Danger' and put into a designated bag for non-combustible garbage.
*Do not put 'Hazardous/Dangerous Garbage' in a designated bag for non-combustible garbage.

Hazardous/Dangerous Garbage (Max. 45-liter transparent bag)

To be collected on the same day as non-combustible garbage

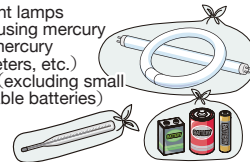
Please separate garbage by type and make sure to tie each bag at the top. (Long fluorescent lamps sticking out of the bag can be collected, as long as it is tied.)

*Non-combustible garbage and Hazardous/Dangerous garbage are collected by different collectors.

- Rechargeable small appliances with non-removable batteries (shavers, handheld fans, etc.)



- Fluorescent lamps
- Products using mercury (clinical mercury thermometers, etc.)
- Batteries (excluding small rechargeable batteries)



- Disposable lighters, spray-cans (The content such as fuel should be completely used, and do not drill holes in the bottom of trash. Plastic lids are combustible garbage.)



*A small bag is OK.

Recyclable Garbage (The method of disposal may change depending on the type of garbage.)

Plants/Trees

How to Dispose

- Small plants, leaves, weeds, etc., should be put in a 45-liter (the same size as a large size designated bag) transparent bag (other than the designated bag) for collection.
- Plants and trees should be cut into about 50 cm length pieces and bound with string so that one bundle is about 10 kg.

Volume of Garbage

- Up to 6 bags (or bundles) at a time (total 6 items for both). For more than that, please take out on the next collection day.



*Water-moist garbage should be put in a bag with small holes at the bottom.

For collecting big tree branches and trunks, reservation call is required.

(please contact by 3:00 p.m. on the previous day of the collection day/excl. Saturdays, Sundays and national public holidays.)

- Tree branches or trunks with a diameter of 5 cm or more should be cut in 50 cm or less, bind with string so that one bundle is about 10 kg.

Not Allowed

- Timber, plywood, square logs, etc. (Some may be painted or stained with wood preservatives cannot be recycled into compost.)
- Large pieces of wood should be separated as 'Bulk Garbage'.

Paper

- Newspapers/flyers
- Books/magazines (incl. candy boxes, tissue boxes, etc.)
- Cardboard
- Drink boxes/milk cartons (they should be rinsed with water and spread out.)



How to Dispose

- Please bind together with string for each type. Paper string is preferable.
- Do not put in a plastic bag or a paper bag distributed from newspaper companies.
- On a rainy day, please postpone until the following week to the extent possible. (Wet paper cannot be recycled)
- Dirty paper cannot be recycled.

Cans

- Drink cans, canned food cans, snack cans, mosquito coil cans, etc.



Bottles

- Juice, sake, vitamin drink, seasoning, medicine, etc.



*Please dispose of Broken bottles, oil bottles and metal caps as non-combustible waste.

Plastic bottles

- Drinks, sake, Japanese sweet cooking wine, soy sauce, etc.



How to Dispose

- Remove caps from drinks and dispose of plastic as burnable waste and metal as non-burnable waste.
- Rinse and Don't crush
- For a plastic bottle, the label should be peeled off.
- Put cans, bottles and plastic bottles into a bucket/basket all together. (They will not be collected if put into a bag.)

Bulk Garbage (Disposal tickets required)

(L) 600 Yen

for an item with the weight of 10 kg or more

(S) 300 Yen

for an item rather than (L)

- 2(S) disposal tickets can be used as a(L) disposal ticket.
- (L) or (S) disposal tickets can be used for items with the length of 2 m or less.

How to Dispose

Bulk garbage will be collected after contact is made by telephone. Please contact from 8:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. (excl. Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays).

- Please affix bulk garbage disposal ticket on each item. (You can take out 15 items at a time.)
- Bulk garbage disposal ticket are available at supermarkets and convenience stores in Urasoe City.

Caution 1 Bulk garbage will not be collected if it does not have a proper price disposal ticket on. 2 Any garbage that is considered to damage the collection truck (such as dumbbells, barbells, timbers, etc.) should be treated as bulk garbage, even if it can be put in a designated bag. 3 It may take more than 1 week to collect bulk garbage, so please make a reservation call at your earliest convenience. 4 Please take out your bulk garbage by 8:00 a.m. It is collected before evening. Collection trucks take different route depending on the garbage reservation condition every time, and you cannot choose the pick-up time. 5 For changing or canceling the bulk garbage reservation, please contact by 3:00 p.m. the day before the collection day.

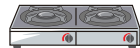
Household Furniture

*About 50 kg that can be lifted by two persons.

- Drawers, desks, chairs, beds, tables, sofas, etc. Please make sure to measure length, width, and height of the garbage before making a reservation call for collection.

Electric Appliances

- Microwaves, stove burners, etc.



Bedclothes

- Futons, carpets
- Mattresses, beds, etc.

*A Futon may be taken out in a combustible garbage bag, if it can be put in a medium-sized bag that allows for tying up at the top properly.

Other

- Timber, plywood, square logs, storage boxes, etc. that cannot be disposed as combustible garbage.



- Laundry poles
- Bean bags (They should be put in a plastic bag.)

Hard-to-Manage Materials to Disposal

Please ask a specific industrial waste processor for collection.

- Fire extinguishers
- Motorbikes, cars (incl. parts)
- Lithium ion batteries
- LP gas cylinders
- Tires
- Small rechargeable batteries
- Water tanks
- Batteries
- Button cell batteries
- Pianos
- *Other waste that can be hazardous.



Natural products

- Soil, Rocks, Sand are all natural products.
- Natural products cannot be collected as garbage by the city.

Home Appliances that are object to the home (electric) appliances recycling law (TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, dryers, air-conditioners.)

*Please ask the retailer that you bought home appliances from, or the collection operators for collecting above home appliances.

General waste from business activities (Business Waste)

- 'Business Waste' is a waste that is from all business activities for profit or not-for-profit purposes.
- Restaurants, offices, individually-run stores, schools, clinics/hospitals, social welfare facilities, etc.
- Please ask the collectors authorized by the city for these waste collection.
- It is not allowed to dispose 'Business Waste' as household garbage, regardless of its type or quantity.

Home Personal Computers

- For disposal of a home personal computer, please inquire with the respective manufacturer.
